## MAGNET NIGHT ~ FAQ

Magnet Night is a Teacher Conference Night by appointment.

### When is Magnet Night?

- There are 2 Magnet Nights: Fall (10/16/25) and Spring (3/26/26).

### How do you get an appointment with the teacher?

- Some teachers will reach out to you to request a conference if your student is struggling.
- Some teachers will share a sign up sheet on Schoology (or via Schoology messages).
- You can also contact your teacher for an appointment.
- In **4th-6th grade**, team teachers may set up joint conference slots to meet with the full team at once (e.g., both the English/History and Math/Science teacher at once).
- **Slots are limited.** Teachers may prioritize students who are most in need of support.

### What if I cannot make Magnet Night or no slots are left?

- Contact your teacher (via Schoology messages or email).
- Most teachers have a conference period when they can meet with parents/guardians.
- Need the teacher's email address? Most teachers put their emails on the class syllabus, or you can search for the teacher in the [Staff Directory](#) and fill out the email form.

### Does my student come with me?

- Unlike Back to School and Open House **students only come to Magnet Night if requested by the teacher**, otherwise students should not attend.
