## GRADING PERIODS

- There are 4 grading periods every semester:

1

### 5 Week

Fall Ends 9/12/25  
Spring Ends 2/13/26

2

### 10 Week

Fall Ends 10/10/25  
Spring Ends 3/20/26

3

### 15 Week

Fall ~ 11/7/25  
Spring Ends 5/1/2026

4

### 20 Week

Fall Ends 12/19/25  
Spring Ends 6/10/26

\*Students should follow teacher deadlines for each grading period, as **some teachers may require assignments to be submitted in advance of the grading period** deadline so there is time to grade the assignment.

## REPORT CARD LINGO

### Progress and Midterm Reports

- **Progress Reports:** These reports show a student's progress after Weeks 5 & 15 of each semester.
- **Midterm Mark Report:** This report shows a student's progress through Week 10 of each semester.
- Progress Reports & Midterm Mark Reports help students (and parents/guardians) understand how students are currently doing in each class.
- Progress Reports and Midterm Mark Reports do NOT reflect the final grade for the class, but they may affect a student's eligibility to participate on sports teams in High School (if GPA is less than 2.0).

### Final Report Card

- **Report Card:** The final report card that you get at the end of each semester (Week 20), that reflects the grade for the entire semester for the class.
- These grades are included on transcripts (and for High School students, these are the grades sent to colleges).

## SCHOOLOGY

- You can check Schoology between grading periods to see your child's daily progress (and to see if there is any missing work).
- You can sign up to receive weekly Schoology email summaries to see your child's progress.
